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## Conditions of entry

- Entry cost is \$5.00 per act. Proof of age and address may be required. All entry fees will be donated to the Recreation Sports and Aquatics Club (RSAC). Entry fees are not refundable.  
The Recreation Sports and Aquatics Club provide ability options for persons with a disability.

- Entry is open to youth aged up to 25 years and must meet one or more of the following locality conditions:
  - Must reside in the Canterbury Bankstown Council LGA
  - Attend school in the Canterbury Bankstown Council LGA
  - Be a member or representative of a Local Group with a registered address in the Canterbury Bankstown Council LGA
- Entrants must supply where appropriate a backing track on either a CD or in MP3 format on either USB stick or electronic device such as an iPhone, etc. Backing tracks may be requested by 2BACR 100.9FM before the performance date.
- Heat winners must be available for the Grand Final on **Sunday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April, 2017.**
- **Judges' decision will be final** and no correspondence will be entered into
- Judges' sheets may be available for feedback for heat performances upon request at [2bacr@tpg.com.au](mailto:2bacr@tpg.com.au)
- All entrants must either email or post a photo and bio. Please limit bio to approx. 100 words. The bio will be read out as an introduction to their performance. The photo will be used as visual reference for 2BACR 100.9FM volunteers and judges, and will not be used as a promotional tool, so therefore does not need to be a professional shot. - All entrants must be 25 or under during the course of the quest. An entrant means a contestant, whether solo or a member of a group entering the quest.
- All entrants are asked to be at Padstow RSL Club at 1.30pm regardless of what their scheduled heat time is. This is to ensure smooth running of the event and that courtesy is shown to all performers with no walk-ins whilst a contestant is on stage.
- Contestants are required to perform 1 song, instrumental piece or speech etc., in the heats. The heat item must not go longer than five (5) minutes.
- Heat winners progress through to the Grand Final. There are also some Wildcard positions up for grabs
- Finalists may perform 2 songs, instrumental pieces, speeches etc. in the Grand Final. The Grand Final Items must not go longer than seven (7) minutes in total. 2 songs/items are not essential, and if only one item is performed it will not impact on the judges' results. Grand Finalists do not have to perform the same act as they did in their heat.
- There will be an overall Grand Final Winning act that will receive \$1000.00. There will also be a winning act for each category that will receive \$500.00. There will be a total of four (4) winners. The three categories are as follows:
  - **Sing it** – Vocalists performing to a backing track or accompanied by no more than 1 musician
  - **Say it** – Public Speaking, Comedians, Poetry Slam, Drama, Magicians etc.
  - **Play it** – Bands & Instrumentalists



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## **Conditions of entry**

- The total prize pool for the competition is \$2500.00. Winning acts will be issued with an Australian cheque and must be deposited into an Australian bank account.
- For contestants in the “**Sing it and Play it**” categories, one (1) accompanying musician, band leader or conductor per act may be over 25 years old to assist with entrants. However, this person must not be the headline performer, front person, or perform a solo as this is a **Youth** Talent Quest. Any person over 25 years in any performance who is viewed to be unfairly disadvantaging other acts will cause their entry to be disqualified.
- For contestants in the “**Say it**” category, sound effects and backing music is allowed providing that it does not overpower the speaking content of the item, and therefore change it to a vocalist “**Sing it**” style performance.
- All performances must not contain any swearing, promote the use of prohibited substances, tobacco or alcohol or include any inappropriate content or be likely to cause offence. As this is a youth event, performances may be stopped if viewed to be unsavoury and the act will be instantly disqualified.
- All entrants will be contacted to confirm heat dates and times. It is essential that all contact details on the entry form are legible and current. The phone number supplied on the entry form must be contactable or have a message service attached to it.
- Entrants will be judged on the following categories; Dress, Stage Presence, Music & Vocal Ability where appropriate, Spoken content where appropriate, Audience Response and Overall Performance.
- All entrants under the age of 18 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult at all times within the club and therefore may not be ‘dropped off’ at the venue. Any entrant without an appropriate parent or guardian present will be disqualified.
- Entrants may participate in other quests and competitions, however please consider this when entering the 2BACR Youth Talent Quest as positions are limited and may be forfeited if a conflict occurs.
- As there are limited heat spaces available, participants will be allowed entry on a first come, first served basis. Once the heat spaces are filled 2BACR reserves the right to declare the Heats full, and no further entries will be accepted.
- The 2BACR 100.9FM “**Sing it, Say it, Play it!**” Youth Talent Quest is a competition for **amateur** performers. We ask that professional youth artists do not enter. However if you are a professional youth artist and are interested in featuring as a performer at the event please contact Wendy Lindsay at [2bacr@tpg.com.au](mailto:2bacr@tpg.com.au) or 9709 3816.
- Please be respectful of everyone’s talents, and applaud all contestants.
- Videeing and Flash Photography during performances is strictly prohibited. The use of phone cameras is also prohibited.

Grand Final tickets will be \$5.00 for persons aged 18 and over. All funds raised through entrance fees will be donated to the RSAC.
